

Second Grade Curriculum

The primary focus of second grade is to build on the fundamental skills acquired in first grade.

The students receive their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion with their class as part of their faith formation.

Reading is conducted using a leveled group model. Reading intervention is available to those students struggling with reading comprehension and phonics. Second grade builds on the basic reading concepts learned in first grade and develops the students into more critical readers.

Students continue their study of math concepts moving into regrouping for addition and subtraction. Several different methods are taught to achieve these goals so students are confident with their work.

Beginning paragraph writing is taught where students are encouraged to think beyond the basic model and to be more creative in their language use. In order to have a firm basis of English language usage, grammar skills are emphasized through both sentence structure and creative writing.
